



Lynne Marie Haas

May 26, 1940 - September 8, 2018

Westwood resident, Lynne Marie Haas, passed from this life unexpectedly early Saturday morning, September 8, 2018 at Seneca Healthcare District following complications from recent surgery. Her loving sister was at her side.

Born May 26, 1940 in Yreka, CA, she was raised and educated in a one room school house in the Northern California community of Greenview before attending Etna High School, graduating as a member of the "Class of 1958".

Shortly out of high school, after being introduced by friends, she married the man who became her best friend and love of her life, Arvid Haas on June 15, 1958. Arvid was soon drafted into the military and the newlyweds moved first to Fort Ord, California and later to Tacoma, WA. Following her husband's discharge the couple moved to the Northeastern California Lumber community of Westwood where Arvid was a native son.

First and foremost a loving wife and mother, Lynne in 1978 began a career with the Westwood Unified School District as the high school's Librarian, retiring in 2005.

Lynne loved her community and was there to serve in their PTA, helping out in Little League, was an original volunteer for Sierra Hospice and was dedicated to CASA. In 1980 she became Westwood's first female EMT. Lynn enjoyed the comradery of Bunco, was an avid reader and will be remembered for bringing laughter to so many through her love of joke telling.

In her untimely passing Lynne leaves her sons; Chris Haas and his wife Tammy of Montague, CA, Greg and his wife Barbara of Peoria, AZ, was the proud grandmother to Travis and James Haas and Jake and Rachel Wilkins and great grandmother to Karter Haas. She is also survived by a brother; Laddie Palmer of Etna, CA and sister; Judy Draughon of Fallon, NV.
